MAC & CHEESE MEAL PACKING EVENT

- Started in 2007 in Naples, Florida, Meals of Hope is a non-profit organization with the goal to package and distribute fortified meals to those in need.
- Locally, Summit Rotary of Greensboro purchased equipment to accommodate a 100 person meal packing, assembly line event that produced approximately 50,000 fortified dried macaroni and cheese meals (6 meals/bag) at one 2 hour event. A back to back event was held in February 2013 and 2014 with 64,000 meals packed each year. In 2015 and 2016, over 100,000 meals were packed
- Fortified meals include macaroni, soy protein, 21 vitamins and minerals, packet of cheese sauce.
- For 18.5 cents per meal you can choose where the meals go. Given that 57% of the 73,000 students in the Greensboro Guilford County public schools receive subsidized lunches Summit Rotary has partnered with the non-profit "**The Out of the Garden Project**" that provides food for food insecure students on weekends. Additional meals will also go to local food pantries.
- Both **Meals of Hope** and the **Summit Rotary Foundation** are non-profit, 501c3 organizations so all donations are tax deductible.
