

FOUNDATION GOALS 2020-2021

Annual Fund

- All clubs encouraged to reach EREY and Sustaining Club Status \$100 per member
- A net gain of thirty (30) new Paul Harris Society Members
- One new Triple Crown Club
- A 5% increase in giving to the Annual Fund from 2019-2020 Rotary year

Endowment Fund/Major Gifts

- Ten (10) new Bequest Society members (Minimum \$10,000)
- Five new Major Gifts (Minimum \$10,000)

End Polio Now

- All clubs raise funds for End Polio Now Goal of \$60 per member
- All clubs participate in World Polio Day/World's Greatest Meal
- All clubs appoint a PolioPlus Chair
- All clubs promote District 7690 PolioPlus Society

Grants and Vocational Training Teams (VTT)

- Each club participate in one or more District Grants
- Each club participates in a Global Grant
- Clubs are encouraged to participate in Vocational Training Team (VTT) opportunities

Scholars

- District identifies, funds and monitors the progress of one new Global Scholar
- District maintains its status as Peace Builder District
- Clubs are encouraged to identify a potential Peace Fellow Scholar

Foundation Banquet & Paul Harris Society Appreciation Event

- 15% of a Club's membership or at least 12 people (spouses or Alumni of Rotary included) to attend the Foundation Banquet in November 2020
- All Paul Harris Society members are highly encouraged to attend the Paul Harris Society Appreciation Event when scheduled

District Rotary Foundation Committee

- Full communication with Foundation Advocates of all District Rotary Foundation Sub-Committees
- Feature District Rotary Foundation Committee at District Events
- Encourage Foundation Advocates to monitor and assist clubs' achievement of Foundation Sub-Committees' goals
- Full integration of Foundation Advocates into Area Leadership Team
- Encourage Foundation Advocates to attend Area Presidents' meetings
